- **WHY Volunteer?**
 - Westminster Home Connection repairs and modifies homes to empower older adults and people with disabilities to age in place safely and with dignity. Our work preserves affordable housing.
- **WHO can Volunteer?**
 - 9th grade and older
- **WHAT do Volunteers do?**
 - **Construction Repairs/Mobility Modifications**
 - *Professional construction staff are onsite to lead these projects*
 - Common Tasks: demolitions, sidewalks, decks, steps, and ramps
 - Site support: Providing lunch, Leading devotional, etc.
 - Work crews are organized out of our office at 3900 West End Ave, Nashville, TN and usually meet on site at the project location.
 - **Declutter**
 - Declutter and unpack
 - Work at client's house with volunteer supervision.
 - **Leadership**
 - Spread news that repairs preserve affordable housing
 - Coordinate volunteer projects
 - Coordinate lunches for volunteers
 - Serve on committees
 - **Office/Administration**
 - Mailings – newsletters, correspondence and other
 - Social Media
 - Other
- **WHEN can Volunteers participate?**
 - **Volunteer Weekend Projects** – Monthly – 3rd weekend of the month (Friday and/or Saturday)
 - **Declutter** – Periodic “Opt-In” list
 - **Office/Administration**
 - Mailings - (4) newsletters per year (reporter, address envelopes, stuff, stamp, mail)
 - Social Media - monthly

 - Most volunteer projects are in Davidson County. Sometimes there are volunteer opportunities in Robertson, Sumner, Wilson, Rutherford, Williamson, and Cheatham counties
